All teachers unable to attend one of the State KEEP training sessions will need to attend one training offered by Jordan School District.

PAY

Teachers attending the training will receive a set of testing materials and a stipend. The stipend is \$125. Teachers in year-round schools who attend the training, while still in session, will have a substitute provided in lieu of the stipend.

The USBE has recently approved a mandate for a common statewide Kindergarten Entry and Exit Profile (KEEP) assessment for students entering Kindergarten. Concepts covered will include letter recognition (names & sounds), concepts of print, first sounds, name writing, rote counting, numeral recognition, shape creation, one-to-one correspondence, and oral language. If you haven't attended the State training, please attend <u>one</u> of these trainings so you will be prepared to administer the new KEEP assessment. At the training, you will receive all materials needed to administer the KEEP.
